

NOTICE OF CHANGE IN TARIFFS
Colorado Natural Gas, Inc., 10825 E. Geddes Avenue, Suite 410, Centennial, CO 80112

You are hereby notified that Colorado Natural Gas, Inc. (“CNG”) has filed with the Colorado Public Utilities Commission (“PUC”) an application for permission to modify its gas cost adjustment rates to become effective April 1, 2024, if the application is granted by the PUC. If granted, this change in rates will affect all sales customers.

This is notice of CNG’s Gas Cost Adjustment (“GCA”) filing for the gas purchased on behalf of its customers. CNG only recovers actual costs from our customers with no mark-up on or to the purchase price of the natural gas. CNG does not earn money on gas costs; *we pay exactly what you pay*. Your cost per therm is changing from your current GCA rate and goes into effect for the period from April 2024 through October 2024.

The reason for the change in gas rates is to changes in the commodity costs, incurred by CNG, in accordance with the PUC approved GCA formula as set forth in CNG's tariff.

A copy of the application, along with the proposed and present rates and tariffs are available for examination at the business office of Colorado Natural Gas, Inc., located at 10825 E. Geddes Avenue, Suite 410, Centennial, CO 80112, CNG's website: <https://www.coloradonaturalgas.com>, and at the PUC at 1560 Broadway, Suite 250 Denver, Colorado, 80202. Anyone who desires may file written objection or may seek to intervene as a party in the proceeding. If you only wish to object to the proposed action, you may file a written objection with the PUC. The filing of a written objection by itself will not allow you to participate as a party in any proceeding on the proposed action. If you wish to participate as a party in this matter, you must file written intervention documents in accordance with the PUC's Rules.

Anyone who desires to file written objection or written intervention documents to the proposed action shall file them with the Colorado Public Utilities Commission, 1560 Broadway, Suite 250, Denver, Colorado, 80202 at least one day before the proposed effective date. Members of the public may attend any hearing and may make a statement under oath about the proposed change whether or not a written objection or request to intervene has been filed.
